Father James Miller ^{McCrie} went to Grand Haven, Michⁿ to work as a young man on the Grand Trunk Railroad, with his brother John who helped build bridges & railroad cars. (John became a foreman ^{at the} of carbarns over 5,800 men in Detroit. In accident at carbarns, a beam hit him on head, tumor developed & he died in 1890, 56 yrs. old.)

James married Anna Anthony & they lived in Grand Haven where their two children were born. When young James W. was 4 yrs old, they moved to Detroit where James ^{and John did carpentry work} worked at carbarns. ^{James later worked} later on the grain elevator as foreman. 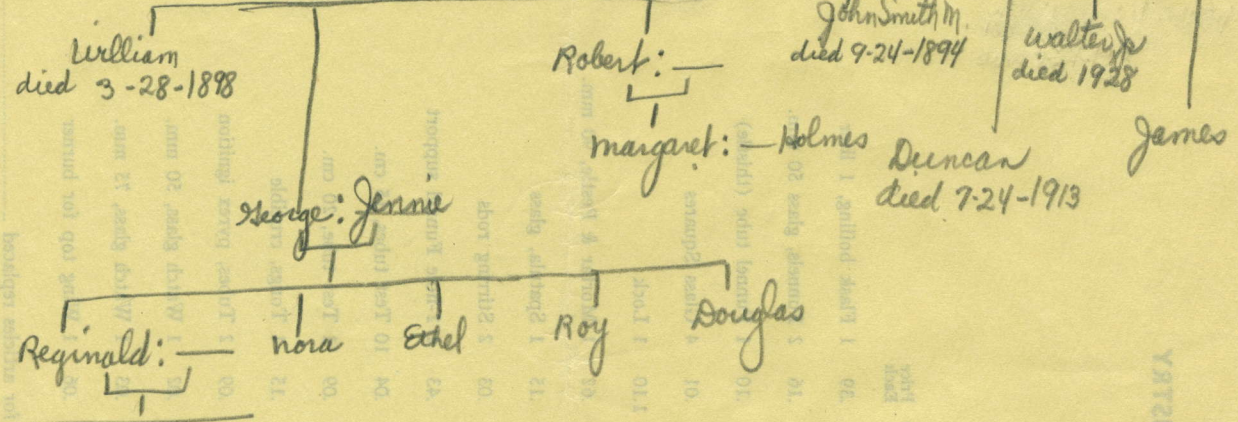
