

July 13, 1945

Dear Mom,

Guess I'll have a talk with you while I am eating my breakfast. Got your Air mail yesterday in the afternoon so we must have had two deliveries.

Robert must be home when Jeannette is going to be married in ~~at~~ such a short time.

It sounds like your garden is doing wonderfully. We had fresh corn for dinner last night, but it wasn't out of our garden, it will be nice though when I can have those golden bantam ears for lunch and dinner.

Betty had quite a day yesterday, she didn't sleep more than an hour and a half from 9:30 yesterday morn til 10:00 last night. Nothing seemed to please her. So I bundled her up at 3:30 and took her out

in the back yard for 40 min. Later I found out that it was gas in her bowels that caused all the trouble. Shortly after 6 P.M. she had a much bigger movement than she ever had even when I had had milk of magnesia. Even after that she still had gas but finally went to sleep at 10 P.M.

We thought we had ^{her} broken of her 2 A.M. feeding but yesterday morn she crossed us up at 3 A.M. & demanded to be fed. She did better today though, cause she slept through til 5:30.

We put her blue wrapper on her yesterday, the one with the kitten and ball of thread, she looked real nice in it.

Len brings up my breakfast every morning, has it up by 7:20 too. Altman was here the last two days. Colonel Penicke in Detroit has been retired because of poor health. He had a stroke shortly after his last visit here. The new Colonel will be in town next

Monday accompanied by Altman.

We did go to the show the other evening. Elizabeth was sleeping when we left and was still snoring snoring when we returned after 10 P.M. We had our dinner after the show at the Hot Shoppe. We didn't have enough in the house to have dinner before we left so we let it go til later. The picture started at 7:00 & we didn't get out til after 9:00. Mickey Rooney was in the movie but he didn't act his "Cocky" self. It was a good show, different from the mill of the run and had awfully good color too.

We go to the Dr. tonite and I have a million questions to ask him

Diety's go away tomorrow and then quietness will reign. - I'll probably go nuts. Sounds like I hear Karl home today. Aint got no more to say, so will close.

We didn't get a letter from Schultz's yet this week
