

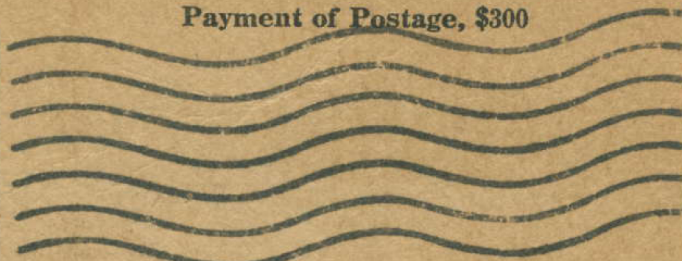
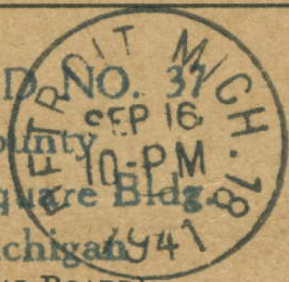

Gentlemen: Last September you placed me in Class 1-H. I have now been reclassified as 1-A. I would like to appeal to you to reconsider my case because I now am married and my wife is dependent on me.

At the time of our marriage, September 27, 1941, my wife and I both felt that there was little chance that I might be sent away for a year's military because I was 29 years old. At the time, men over 28 were being exempted.

I have figured that it costs about fifteen to twenty dollars per week to support my wife. I am earning \$42.50 per week at the present time, <sup>(P2)</sup> and have been unable to save any money since we have been married.

I am greatly concerned about my wife's welfare should the government decide it needs me in the army.




I am writing with reference to the above named registrant about whom we wrote you a few days ago. Mr. Schutze called at our office this morning and asked that we clarify his position with you.

Mr. Schutze appealed his I-A classification on the grounds of dependency only, but the classification of the Local Board (I-A) was sustained by the Appeal Board with a split decision of 3-2. In an appeal case on the grounds of dependency when there is a dissenting vote, the file is sent to Washington for further disposition by the President.

Mr. Schutze has never attempted to obtain further deferment because of his occupation since his appeal was denied. We have received your letter regarding his present position and assure that every consideration will be given him as soon as his file is returned to us from Washington.
