MRS. GERTRUDE KERR DIED AT HOSPITAL

Mrs. Gertrude Kerr, 63, of South Main Street, died Monday night at 7:15 at Community Hospital. She was taken ill Saturday; and her death was due to complications.

Funeral arrangements await word from her son in Colorado; but the service probably will be held Friday afternoon at Deck's Chapel; and burial will be in Maplewood Cemetery at North Baltimore.


She was a native of Crestline, Ohio, and her maiden name was Gertrude White. She was united in marriage with James E. Kerr at Kenton, Ohio, in 1903. They resided in Rudolph for some years and then went to Illinois. In 1917 they came to Bowling Green to reside. Mr. Kerr passed away in April, 1942.

Mrs. Kerr was a member of Trinity United Brethren Church of Bowling Green and had been active in it. She leaves many friends in passing.
