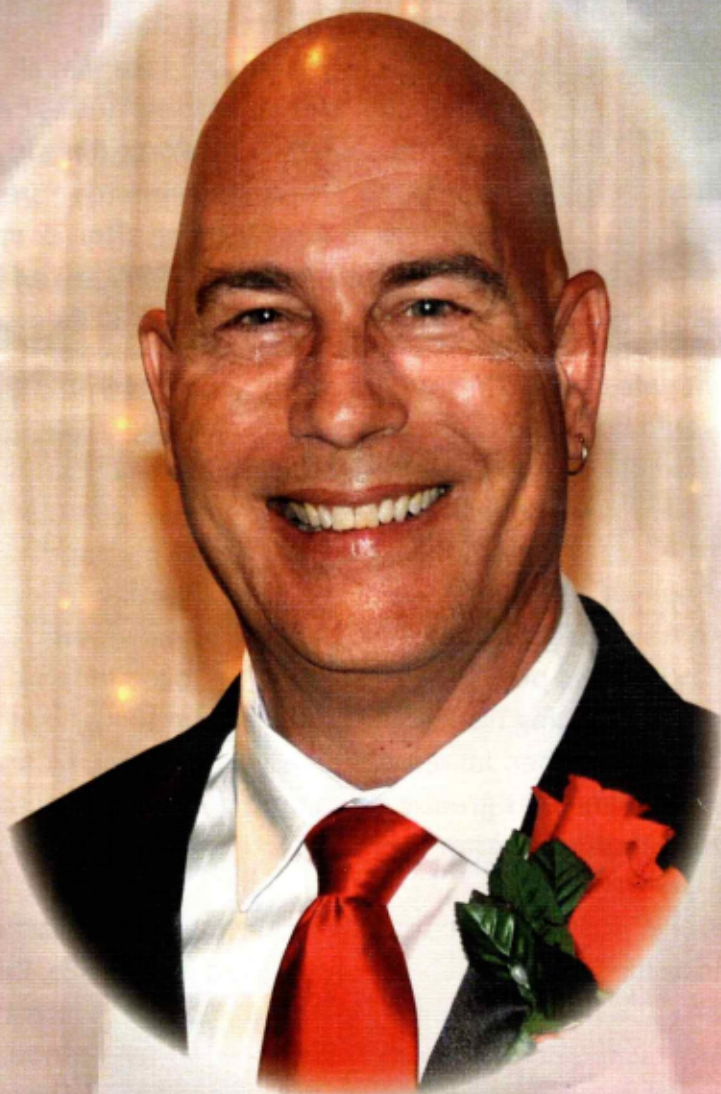


James P. Bartlett

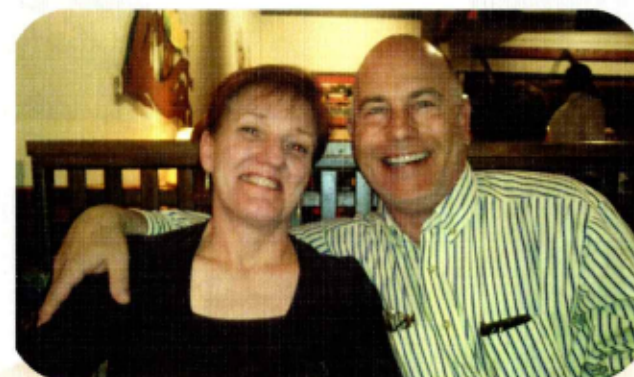

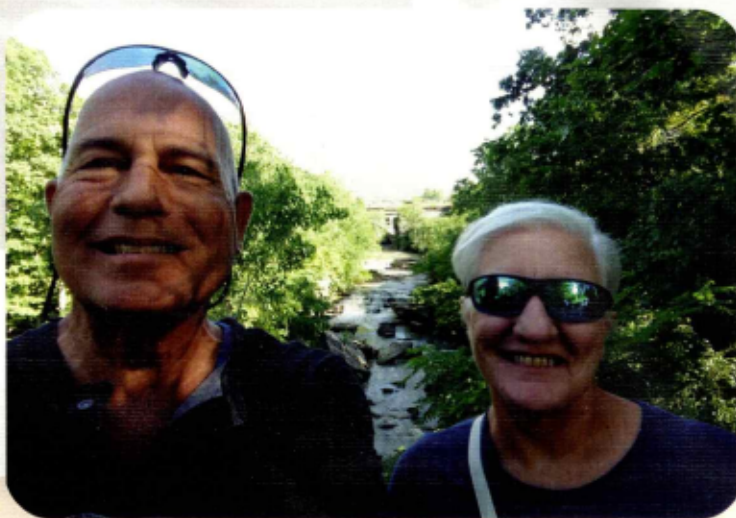
